### Andrew Fraser joins Cityspace

Which companies are hiring, who's firing and where do top executives seem to be playing musical chairs? We put the spotlight on the movers and shakers, telling you who is coming and going. It may be the departure or arrival of a board member, or it could be a spate of staff changes in one company. We've scoured the Library House database to identify the key moves that have come to our attention during the past few weeks, and compiled a catalogue of arrivals and departures to keep you up-to-date.

#### Chief Executives

Andrew Fraser has joined Cityspace, the urban digital network company based in Notting Hill, London, as chief executive. Previously divisional managing director for public sector company Civica, he will oversee the expansion of Cityspace's established transport division to deliver digital network systems for UK train operating companies. Prior to Civica, he spent seven years with Idox where he led a management buy-in from Lombard Risk Systems and subsequent flotation on the London Stock Exchange.

Mr Fraser has been involved with technology businesses since 1972, including Lombard Risk Systems as sales and marketing director (global) and seven years with Wang UK and Ireland. He spent 16 years in the armed forces with the Royal Signals (Army). Cityspace focuses on delivering cost effective real-time passenger information and transactional services at the point of need. "These services are high on the agenda of every UK rail operator, transport authority and passenger transport executive." Mr Fraser says.
