Wi-Fi arrives at St Pancras

Being the international hub for Europe, it is only to be expected to find that free Wi-Fi has been made available at St Pancras International train station.

This means that travelers will be able to get connected while waiting for their train through a laptop or other Wi-Fi enabled device.

The station has been going through an extensive £800 million renovation process which has lasted almost ten years and is now the home of the Eurostar's London Terminal, highlighting the importance of providing up to date facilities in order for them to compete with air travel.
